DAY 1 WEDNESDAY, JULY 29

FAIRBANKS

Today, we will transfer to the airport for our flight to **Fairbanks, AK**, known as "The Golden Heart City" due to its gold rush history and welcoming people. Upon our arrival, we'll meet our local guide and head to the **Pike's Lodge** (or similar) for a two-night stay, with the remainder of the day at our leisure to settle in and enjoy dinner on our own.

DAY 2 THURSDAY, JULY 30

FAIRBANKS

(B, D)

Enjoy breakfast before we **embark on a scenic cruise on the Chena River aboard an authentic sternwheeler**, soaking in Alaska's frontier spirit and breathtaking landscapes. Then, **explore Fairbanks on a guided tour**, uncovering Native culture at the Morris Thompson Cultural Center and marveling at the Trans-Alaska Pipeline, a marvel of engineering that shaped the state's oil industry. Tonight, we will gather for a delicious group dinner.

DAY 3 FRIDAY, JULY 31

DENALI

(B, S)

This morning, we set off on an unforgettable journey into the heart of **Denali National Park** with a **Tundra Wilderness Tour**. The park encompasses six million acres of stunning forests, mountains, glaciers, and lakes, with only one road interrupting the terrain! Keep your eyes peeled, and you might see a shaggy grizzly sow watching over rambunctious cubs, a lone bull moose browsing in thick willows, or a rare full-curl Dall sheep bedded down high upon a craggy ridge. A snack will be provided during the tour. Our day will end at the **Denali Park Village** (or similar), and the remainder of the day will be spent at our leisure.

DAY 4 SATURDAY, AUGUST 1

TALKEETNA

(B, L)

We will board the renowned **Alaska Railroad** for an exciting morning as we soak in some of the Last Frontier's most spectacular scenery along the rails from Anchorage to Talkeetna. Founded in 1914, the railroad has a mainline over 656 miles long! Onboard hosts will captivate us with their narration and highlight the many landmarks visible through the dome railcar's large picture windows. Enjoy a delightful lunch as you glide through Alaska's most stunning scenery. Upon arrival in **Talkeetna**, the rest of the day is yours to explore before settling in at the beautiful **Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge** (or similar).

DAY 5 SUNDAY, AUGUST 2

ANCHORAGE

(B)

This morning, enjoy some leisurely time to explore, sip coffee, or simply soak in the scenery. Then, board a comfortable coach for a scenic journey south to **Anchorage**, where breathtaking mountain and coastal views welcome us. Upon arrival, a brief overview tour of the city before we settle into the **Anchorage Hilton Hotel** (or similar).

DAY 6 MONDAY, AUGUST 3

WHITTIER

(B, D)

Today's touring will take us to the **Alaska Native Heritage Center** to explore Alaska's eleven major Native cultures and their traditions. The center features permanent collections and traditional Native dwellings that circle Lake Tiulana. Back on the road, we'll transfer to the pier to **board the beautiful Norwegian Jade** and explore our home for the next seven nights.

Activity Level: Moderate

Balanced blend of activity and relaxation with walks or stands of 60-90 minutes, occasional stairs, and daily walks of two to three miles.

DAY 7 TUESDAY, AUGUST 4**CRUISE HUBBARD GLACIER (B, L, D)**

Today, we will experience the wilds of Alaska as we cruise through icy waters to come **face-to-face with the towering Hubbard Glacier**. The strong currents and riptides that flow between Gilbert Point and the face of the glacier cause calving to occur daily, sending massive chunks of ice crashing into Disenchantment Bay. An onboard naturalist will provide narration and help us spot the whales, harbor seals, and otters that hunt and play in the waters of Yakutat Bay. It will be an adventure of a lifetime!

DAY 8 WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 5**ICY STRAIT POINT (B, L, D)**

Venture “where the north wind doesn’t blow.” Known for this famous saying, **Icy Strait Point** is the ideal landing spot for adventurers seeking a new experience. It’s one of the few places in the world where wildlife outnumbers the human population. While in port, optional excursions include experiencing a traditional Tlingit tribal performance and getting up close to humpback whales and brown bears in the wild. Savor fresh Dungeness crab or explore Alaska’s stunning landscapes by gondola, tram, ATV, kayak, or high-speed boat.

DAY 9 THURSDAY, AUGUST 6**JUNEAU (B, L, D)**

A unique destination for many reasons, **Juneau** sits next to the Gastineau Channel in the Alaskan panhandle. There are no connecting roads to other cities, making the capital city only accessible by water and air. Optional excursions in Juneau include kayaking up one of the area’s many protected waterways, embarking on a whale-watching adventure, feasting on salmon, or touring historic downtown.

DAY 10 FRIDAY, AUGUST 7**SKAGWAY (B, L, D)**

The great Klondike Gold Rush lives on in **Skagway’s** charming downtown of restored nineteenth-century buildings and historic railway. Located on the edge of the wilderness, this small town saw its fair share of gold seekers. Excursion options include a scenic ride on a vintage train to the summit of White Pass, panning for gold, canoeing on Summit Lake, or visiting a wildlife refuge.

DAY 11 SATURDAY, AUGUST 8**KETCHIKAN (WARD COVE) (B, L, D)**

Known as the ‘Salmon Capital of the World,’ **Ketchikan** is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit people, who have carved the world’s largest collection of totem poles. Next to the water, you’ll find a neat row of wooden buildings called Creek Street. Today, they are brightly painted boutiques, but their history tells a different story! Optional excursions include wilderness adventures, crab feasts, a lumberjack show, and halibut fishing.

DAY 12 SUNDAY, AUGUST 9**CRUISE INSIDE PASSAGE (B, L, D)**

Get ready for amazing views and wildlife like nowhere else as we sail through the islands of **Alaska’s Inside Passage**.

DAY 13 MONDAY, AUGUST 10**HOME (B)**

We disembark in Vancouver, British Columbia, and catch our flight home.
